FALLS:

Major reason for disability among Older Persons

- High prevalence among older community dwellers:
 - China (18%) (Yu et al., 2009)
 - Hong Kong (19.3%) (Chu et al., 2005)
 - Japan (23%) (Muraki et al., 2013)
- Malaysians: ranged between 15% and 47% (Ibrahim et al., 2017; Sazlina et al., 2008; Devinder et al., 2015)
- Associated with various adverse health complications: injuries, high chances of not able to walk again, poorer QoL, higher rate of death (Ambrose et al., 2013)

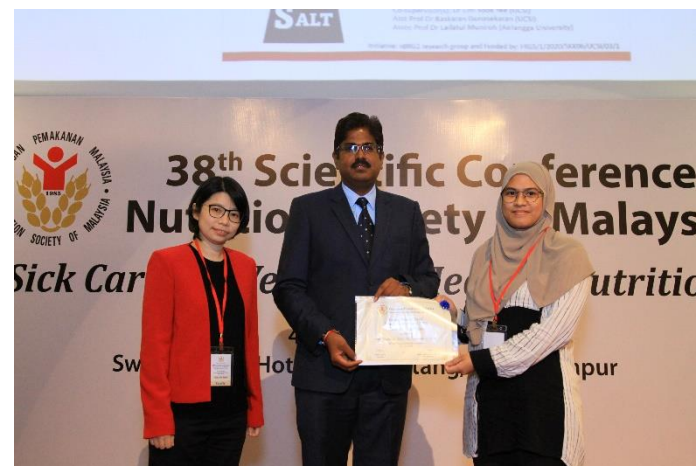
